

## 20 AI tools that can be useful for educators

1. Notebook LM (Google): This AI tool analyzes and summarizes information from various sources like PDFs, websites, and videos, helping educators quickly grasp key content.
2. Brisk Teaching: A Chrome extension that uses AI to adjust reading levels, generate feedback, create lesson plans and quizzes, and more, streamlining educators' workflows.
3. Diffit: This AI text leveler can translate text and YouTube videos to different reading levels and generate summaries, comprehension checks, and vocabulary for diverse learners.
4. MagicSchool AI: A versatile platform with over 80 AI tools, including lesson plan generators, classroom management aids, and content creation features for teachers.
5. Magic Student (MagicSchool): A student-facing tool providing a safe space for students to interact with AI and develop AI literacy skills under teacher control.
6. AutoDraw (Google): This tool combines drawing with AI to help users quickly create custom graphics for presentations, projects, and classroom displays without needing artistic skills.
7. Parlay: A digital tool designed to facilitate meaningful classroom discussions, allowing teachers to track participation, analyze responses, and provide real-time feedback.
8. Maestra AI: Offers a free live transcription tool for audio and video, aiding students with diverse language needs and accessibility requirements through real-time translation and subtitles.
9. Quizizz: This platform allows teachers to customize lessons and quizzes based on individual student data and offers an "AI Enhance" feature to modify questions and personalize practice.
10. Wolfram|Alpha: Provides step-by-step solutions and generates graphs for mathematical concepts, understanding natural language input for math problems.
11. Duolingo for Schools: Utilizes AI, including GPT-4 features, to offer personalized language learning lessons and activities for students.
12. SchoolAI: A platform focused on personalized learning experiences for students, allowing them to ask questions and receive extra help, all monitored by teachers.
13. Eduaide.AI: An AI-powered workspace created by teachers for teachers, simplifying lesson planning, resource creation, and feedback processes while aligning with educational standards.

14. Gamma: Helps teachers create polished and engaging presentations quickly using AI-driven features for design and content suggestions.
15. Class Companion: Provides immediate feedback on student writing, including short answers and essays, with suggestions for improvement.
16. Curipod: Assists teachers in creating interactive slide presentations and can generate full lessons with background information, images, polls, and reflection questions from a single prompt.
17. Gradescope: Uses AI to read handwriting and spot patterns in student work, providing immediate input and streamlining the grading process for tests and projects.
18. Turnitin: Primarily known for plagiarism detection, it also offers features like PeerMark and Feedback Studio to enhance assessment and provide feedback on student work.
19. Speechify: An AI-powered text-to-speech tool that converts various reading materials into audio, making content more accessible with customizable reading speeds and highlighting.
20. Canva: While known for design, Canva also offers AI-powered features for content creation, including text-to-image generation, helping educators create visually appealing materials.
